• Links


- Find a link on the senior web site

- History


• TAP

- Using one finger and firmly touch the screen, then lift your finger
- Use this to select an object or activate a button
- If the thing you are trying to select is text you need to double-tap to select it
- Let's practice





• SCROLL, SWIPE or FLICK

- Slide one finger up and down or side to side
 - To move things around to see outside the viewing area of the screen
 - Swipe or flick up and down to scroll the pages of your document




- MOVE or RESIZE an object
 - To **move** an object, touch and hold the object, then drag it to where you want it
 - To **resize** an object tap it and get hold of one of the handles, then drag to resize
- Select Multiple objects
 - Do one of the following
 - Touch and hold one object on the screen, then tap the other objects with another finger
 - Touch an empty section of the screen and drag the box around the objects






- Pinch open tio ZOOM in
 - Place two fingers on the screen and spread them apart
 - It makes the object larger, see what happens when you do this slowly



- Pinch closed to ZOOM out
 - Place two fingers on the screen to bring them together,.
 - This makes the page smaller and you can see more items on the page.


